



RUSSIAN-ARMENIAN (SLAVONIC) UNIVERSITY

Russian-Armenian (Slavonic) University is one of the leading universities in the South Caucasus region, founded under the joint authority of the Russian Federation and the Republic of Armenia in 1997. On April 29th, 2005 RAU was accredited by the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation. Since its creation the university has been governed by 2 Rectors: the Founding Rector, prominent expert in Russian language and literature, Academician *Mr. Levon Mkrtchyan*, who was followed by former Prime-Minister of the Republic of Armenia, Doctor of Economic Sciences, Professor, Academician of the Russian Academy of Natural Sciences, member of National Academy of Science of Armenia *Mr. Armen Darbinyan* since November 1, 2001.

The first intake of students was held in February 1999 for Departments of Law, Public and Municipal Administration and Journalism. Since then the University has been constantly growing and encompassing new branches of learning and research. Currently, **5 Institutes** with **31 Departments** operate in the University which offer wide range of undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate programs in more than **70 fields of studies**. RAU graduates receive Armenian and Russian state diplomas. Currently, the University offers 22 undergraduate, 4 specialist (BM), 42 graduate and 50 PhD programs. Students receive **Double Diplomas**, accredited by both Armenian and Russian Ministries of Education and Science.

The main goal of the university is to provide RAU graduates with the learning outcomes and professional skills enabling them to work not only in Armenia and Russia, but also in any other country of the world.
