**7.Fields of study, degrees and certificates :** UFAR awards its graduates double degrees, recognized both by Armenia and France: Armenian« Bakalavr »/ « Magistros » and French Licence/Master state diplomas. UFAR uses Armenian and French as languages of instruction and currently offers 3 Bachelor's degree programs in Marketing, Management and Law as well as 3 Master's degree programs in International Business Law, Finance/Audit, and Marketing.

**8.Admission of international students:** Are considered to be foreign entrants those who have completed their secondary education abroad. The foreign entrants have the right to:

a. participate in the special competition organized for foreign entrants with maximum 6 available places per each specialization. In this particular case the aforesaid entrants can undertake the facilitated version of the exam "Armenian Language".

b. participate in the general competition, within the framework of previously anticipated number of places per each specialization. In this case, the international applicants will have to take the same exams as the citizens of the Republic of Armenia do.

Those international applicants who possess French diplomas of general baccalaureate or AbiBac, Bachibac, Esabac and D.A.E.U enter the university without undertaking entering exams.

9. Scholarship policy: In accordance with the results of their admission exams the students can study free of charge or can make use of the system of reduction of tuition fees. Started from the second year free of charge and reduced payment places will be allocated at the end of each academic year based on the results of the exams and taking into consideration the conduct of the student.

**10.Foreign languages :** French is not mandatory at entry to baccalaureate. Intensive courses are run over two years. By the completion of the second year of studies the students are subject to payment for undertaking the exam of French. Started from the third year our students are being taught by the professors of Lion 3 University of Jean Moulin. English is mandatory from the first year. Russian is mandatory from the third year. German and Spanish are optional.

**13.More information :**"French University in Armenia" Foundation (UFAR) is an institution of higher education created in 2000 by the Governments of France and Armenia aimed at bringing the French higher education experience to Armenia. The University was set up based on a 1995 agreement on cultural, scientific and technical cooperation between Armenia and France in collaboration with Jean Moulin University of Lyon. UFAR students receive two degrees upon graduation, allowing them to pursue their education or career in Armenia, France or elsewhere in Europe. One month internships in the fourth year of study are organized in Armenia and France. As a result of successful adaptation of European management, teaching and learning approaches within the local social and economic context and strong relationship with professional

environment, UFAR enjoys a high rate of graduate employment, which comprised more than 70% in 2013.

To promote the educational programs the French University of Armenia receives financial support from several organizations and business companies such as Armenian General Benevolent Union (AGBU), Yerevan Brandy Company, ACBA-Credit Agricole Bank, VivaCell-MTS, French-Armenian Development Foundation, Orange Armenia and others.
